

SCHOOL PAL- PAKS

A project of
Nazarene Compassionate Ministries at
Kokomo First Nazarene Church

The Church of the Nazarene operates numerous primary schools around the world, providing quality education for children. Unfortunately, children around the world often do not have the supplies needed for school. In countries with economic challenges, families cannot afford to purchase supplies, or siblings are often required to share the supplies.

In response to the need, Nazarene Missions International partnered with Nazarene Compassionate Ministries, Inc. (NCM, Inc.) to provide School Pal – Paks

The School Pal – Paks provide students in Nazarene primary schools with the supplies they need to facilitate learning. A Pal – Pak will serve two students and cost about \$10.00.

We invite you to help us fill one-gallon, zip-lock bags each with the following items:

- * TWO Mead composition notebooks – NO spiral-bound notebooks & NO bigger than 9 3/4 x 7 1/2 inches
- * ONE pkg of 10 or 12 Number 2 pencils
- * ONE pkg of 10 or 12 black or blue pens
- * TWO pink erasers, 2 or 3 inches long
- * TWO 12-inch rulers
- * ONE pkg of 12 to 14 colored pencils
- * One pair of blunt-nosed scissors
- * One hand-held pencil sharpener
